GATE ENTRY UPDATE

The Key Card reader system was installed last week. Here is how to purchase and pick up cards:

- Key Cards will be available for purchase on June 13 and June 27 between 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- ♦ Complete the form prior to **driving thru** to receive your card(s). The form was emailed to all residents on May 27 and is also available on the <u>ishoa.org</u> website under FORMS.
- To maintain social distancing without blocking incoming traffic, cards can be picked up by Ashdown Lane near the power lines.
- The cost is \$10 per card and charges will appear on your July HOA dues invoice.
- There are enough cards for each household to have two. Additional cards will be ordered if there is a demand.

On July 15th, the universal code will be deleted and entry into the community will be by:

- ♦ RFID Tags
- ♦ The Keypad
- The smart phone app Watchman EVO
- ♦ The Key Card

TAKE A WALK ON THE NATURE PRESERVE TRAIL!

Enjoy a shady alternative to the sidewalks and streets of Indian Summer, and you may see something interesting. With people at home, more residents are discovering this community resource. Enter from either end by the well-house on Prestwick or behind the golf course clubhouse. Please remember to leave your pets at home, they're not allowed in the Nature Preserve. The trail is also not designed or intended for bicycles - just foot traffic. At times mosquitos can be bothersome and repellent may be useful.
