Gate Keypad Entry System Update

The New Keypad Entry System is now working at all 3 gates!

- ◆ Nothing has changed regarding your vehicle's RFID tags, and the universal code will stay active for now but does not require the # sign before the 4 digit code. NOTE: There is NO # button on the new keypad.
- ◆ (972) 231-1999 is the phone number you will see on your phone when someone is calling you from the gate. You can add it to your contacts in your smart phone.
- ◆ To OPEN the gate from your home phone when you receive a call, press the * key.
- ◆ To open the gate from your mobile phone, press the GREEN button.

If Vantage does not have a telephone number on file for you or your renters you are not in the system and will NOT be able to open the gate for visitors! Please contact Vantage to update your information.
